What we do		
How does Independence Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measure include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We also maintain other physical, electronic and procedural safeguards protect this information and we limit access to information to those employees for whom access is appropriate.	
How does Independence Bank collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Open an account Give us your contact information Make deposits or withdrawals from your account Apply for a loan Show your government-issued ID We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies. 	
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 Federal law gives you the right to limit only sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information, about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
